3. Northern Neck Tourism Expo – July 27th at Dahlgren Heritage Museum – 10am to 3pm. Kathy and Mark are planning to be there, but another spinner would great. The NN tourism people are setting up a NN Scavenger Hunt, they will be sent to our guild looking for "where it is good to warped and a weasel goes "pop."
4. Beginning Weaving class is full, it is scheduled for August 26, 27 & 28 – from 9 – 4. Sandi will get a list out in mid-August for the equipment that we will need to borrow from members. In the mean time she asked that members "adopt" a loom in the studio to clean up and make sure it is in good working order before the class.
5. We will need to reorganize the studio after Grandparent's camp. Jan will work on it this coming Saturday and help would be appreciated.
6. Janice Stewart is going to make name signs for each of our looms. We felt she should be compensated; it was moved, seconded and unanimously approved to pay her \$100.

7. Judy suggested we consider an Intro to weaving technology class. We discussed and decided this would be a good option to add to the list of classes the guild could offer and Kathy will keep it in mind as she starts to organize for the Heritage classes.
